





Animal models have conventionally been used to find disease specific targets, there are huge limitations in terms of predictability or reliability on these models as well as transferability of the results from these animal models to humans. Human biology will always differ from the other species to a varying degree. Although rodents represent the most widely used models for investigating the role and mechanisms of therapeutic strategies due to their easy handling, short gestation time, low maintenance costs, and easy genetic manipulation, their heart function, heart rates and gen/protein expression are different from those of humans. 


