

Report on Management of Students Attributes

The Institution identifies the attributes of admitted students from different backgrounds in various programs. At the time of joining institution has mechanism to identify some attributes of the student in the category of academic, cultural, social, health, economical and remaining attributes during the tenure of program. Institution develops a plan for the holistic development of the students based on the attributes. Attributes follows

Data base of the student: At the tune of entry, Institution collects the student details of educational background, schooling, Gender and Head of the Department allocates mentors to the students for their overall development.

Economic attribute of the Student Being located in rural area, a vast majority of the students join this institution are socially as well as economically backward.
